## TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE USE OF THE TERRAIN

Crondall Pétanque Club and its members disclaim all responsibility and liability with respect to any damage or injury sustained in connection with use of the Club terrain or equipment.

1. All use of the terrain is subject to these terms and conditions.
2. Temporary membership, entitling visitors to play at any time on that day, must be purchased before playing. Boules are available for loan. The level of fees will be set from time to time by the committee.
3. Play by visitors may be curtailed when club matches or competitions are in progress or when weather conditions render the terrain unsuitable. In case of doubt a Club Member must be consulted. This member has authority to determine whether play can start and may curtail play already in progress.
4. All players **must** wear footwear that does not damage the terrain. Spiked shoes and high heels, for example, are not permitted. Ideally trainers or flat shoes should be worn.
5. No litter, including cigarette ends, may be dropped on the terrain. Players are requested to use the ashtrays and waste bins provided.
6. Consumption of alcohol is strictly confined to licensing hours. Drinks may be placed on the ledge provided on the terrain fencing but not on the playing surface. Only food and drink purchased on the premises is permitted. Disregard of this rule will render the offender liable to immediate expulsion from the Club.
7. Children are allowed on the terrain only to play pétanqué and when in the company of an adult.
8. No animals are allowed on the terrain.
9. When not required for club play the terrain may, with prior arrangement, be used by bona fide organisations. Examples of such organisations are Round Tables, U3A, WI etc. All bookings must be made with the Club's Terrain Booking Officer who will provide a copy of these Terms and Conditions. Play will be supervised by one or more Club Members who will organise a competition if required.
10. No smoking is permitted on the playing area of the terrain. Ash trays are provided in the surrounding areas.
11. Temporary members' names must be recorded in a book (or folder) provided, together with the date of play and their signature.
